As parents, we agree to:

1. Submit emergency information form before your child can remain at the school.
2. Fill out and return all necessary forms, including a health/immunization form from your child's doctor. (If you decline vaccinations, please let us know in writing for our files.)
3. Keep your child at home if an illness is developing, if he/she is extremely tired, or has not been free of symptoms or a fever for more than 24 hours.
4. Come to pick up our child as soon as possible if he or she is injured or ill while at school.
5. Refrain from discussions about your child or another child with the teacher or another parent in the child's presence.

6. Discuss with the teacher any information that might shed light on your child's needs or development.
7. Give 20 volunteer hours per year for special activities, fundraisers, parent workdays and assist with school projects.
8. Attend Parent-Teacher conference and participate in Parent Education events.
9. Support the school's policy of conducting an "ease-in" process at the beginning of the school year. (Children come to school for only an hour the first and second day of school, and add a half hour per day until the regular length of the day is reached. This helps greatly to make the child comfortable in the school environment, even if s/he has attended school before.)
10. Recognize that Piedmont Progressive Preschool is a small non-profit organization whose budget is planned on the timely monthly payment of tuition. Therefore, please pay your tuition on time -- it matters! If payment is not made in time, you will be required to pay a \$15 late fee.
11. Recognize that tuition is kept as low as possible while enabling the delivery of high quality care. Monthly tuition is due regardless of scheduled holidays and/or days my child is absent. Tuition Deposit is forfeited if child is withdrawn from school before end of school year.
